Other Information

A minimum of 30 hours must be earned at the University of Missouri-Kansas City, regardless of the number and level of hours earned at another institution. Undergraduate degree-seeking students are required to earn credit in at least 36 hours of coursework numbered 300 and above at UMKC. In the case of transfer credit, the coursework must be numbered as junior-senior level work by the transferring institution. Community-college transfer coursework cannot count towards the 36-hour requirement.

Policy

Program Description

The BM in Voice Performance degree gives students the foundation for a career in professional performance or for graduate study in performance. This degree program is designed for students who are serious about becoming professional soloists, opera singers, studio teachers, recording artists, and other professionals within the business of music. Foundational course work includes core music courses such as history and theory, as well as the practical courses of lessons, ensembles, and recitals.

- Qualify for the first semester freshman level of lessons on classical voice for 4 credits at the audition for admission.
- Must be able to sing standard songs in English on pitch and with satisfactory phrasing and musical intelligence.
- Must demonstrate ability to read a simple song at sight.
